

**Start Referee Duties at Regional events:** This checklist serves as a guide only. Please refer to the ICR for detailed responsibilities. **Bring ICR to race.**

<b>Ensure a fair Safe competition</b>	
	<p><b>Prior to race start:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Start Referee must remain at the start from the beginning of the official inspection time and until the end of the event.</li> <li>• Start coral ensures the safety of competitors, and access for course crew, while ensuring the public cannot access the race run</li> <li>• Ensure forerunner bibs and extra bibs are available at the start</li> <li>• Coordinate with start list organizer, starter and start hand-timer</li> <li>• All are in position before the start</li> <li>• Determine jury member positions on course</li> <li>• Ask Jury for racer intervals</li> <li>• Ensure clear communication of Jury radio: Finish Referee, Timing and Jury</li> <li>• Agree on Radio protocol with Jury (and Finish Referee): Start-Stop, racer down and course clear protocols are established</li> </ul>
	<p><b>During the race:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Radio Protocol: course clear, start-stop, racer, down, course maintenance</li> <li>• Report names of racers who did not start</li> <li>• Ensure racer's equipment adheres to regulations: helmets, baskets on poles, etc</li> <li>• Determine late and false starts</li> <li>• Announce forerunners on course, 1<sup>st</sup> racer on course, last racer on course</li> <li>• Check in with finish referee and jury for re-runs, 10 racers from last racer.</li> </ul>
	<p><b>After the race: (each run)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide list of names/#s of late and false starts to Referee</li> <li>• Relay "course closed" from COR to start area</li> </ul>

**Finish Referee Duties at Regional events:** This checklist serves as a guide only. Please refer to the ICR for detailed responsibilities. **Bring ICR to race.**

<b>Ensure a fair Safe competition</b>	
	<p><b>Prior to race start:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Finish Referee must remain at the finish from the beginning of the official inspection time and until the end of the event.</li> <li>• Ensure the finish in-run and out-run are properly observed.</li> <li>• Determine jury member positions on course</li> <li>• Ask Jury for racer intervals</li> <li>• Ensure clear communication of Jury radio: Start Referee, Timing and Jury</li> <li>• Agree on Radio protocol with Jury (and Start Referee): Start-Stop, racer down and course clear protocols are established</li> </ul>
	<p><b>During the race:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Report to Jury the feedback of forerunners on the race course and conditions</li> <li>• Observe Radio Protocol: course clear, start-stop, racer down, course maintenance</li> <li>• Report racers who did not finish and/or all infringements against the rules</li> <li>• Provide Start Referee and Jury names and #s of re-runs.</li> </ul>
	<p><b>After the race: (each run)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Relay “course closed” from COR to finish area</li> </ul>
