**The Program:**

**Positions:**

These athletes will range in age from 16 – 20 years old with all of them having previously competed in U16 programs or the local Elite NCO FIS Team. The team will participate in pre-season camps and regular training throughout the season as well in local U18 races and Ontario/Quebec FIS races.

There will be approximately 64 on-snow days in the base program including away races, plus additional training/camp opportunities as they arise. Training is typically Tues/Wed Nights and Friday/Saturday/Sunday with the season running from November until April.

The club is very supportive of the U18 program and with a robust coaching staff will support the U18 Program as required. In addition, for the U18 Program Lead there will exist other opportunities throughout the season to participate at any of our three pre-season away camps across all age groups. We can help you achieve your personal professional goals AND help develop valuable coaching skills for future endeavors. Our coaches are provided many opportunities and support including away and mini-camps, mentorship, regular course setting clinics, regular sessions, educational components and financial assistance for improving certifications.
